The Civil War - The Journey of a New Hampshire Patriot

Under the direction of board member Dave Munn, this new show will be a story of the Civil War and New Hampshire troops' involvement. Along with re-enactors, there will be music from the time period — fife and drums and more. Performances will take place on Friday, May 26 at 7 PM; Saturday, May 27 at 7 PM; with a Sunday matinee at 2 PM May 28, all at the Whipple Town Hall in New London. Tickets will be available at Tatewell Gallery and Morgan Hill in New London as well as at the door.

Songs and Tales of WWI

November 11, 2017 is the 100th anniversary of Armistice Day (now called Veterans Day). SKIT was approached by the Warner Historical Society to commemorate this occasion. Wally Borgen is creating a musical about the historical events leading up to the war and interesting facts about the war. Many fabulous songs were written in that time period including "It's a Long, Long Way to Tipperary," "Over There," "I Wonder Who's Kissing Her Now," and so, so many more that will be included in the production. It will be an event you won't want to miss.

The production will be in the fall at the Warner Town Hall. Look for more details about date and time in the Kearsarge Shopper. We are looking for any WWI memorabilia or old family photographs (to scan into a PowerPoint presentation) that we might borrow for the show.

Musical Comedy

We also have on our agenda a request to revive one of Tom Lowe's musical comedy shows that were so popular here in the 1970s and '80s. We hope to have a production in the works for 2018. We hope to see you there!
